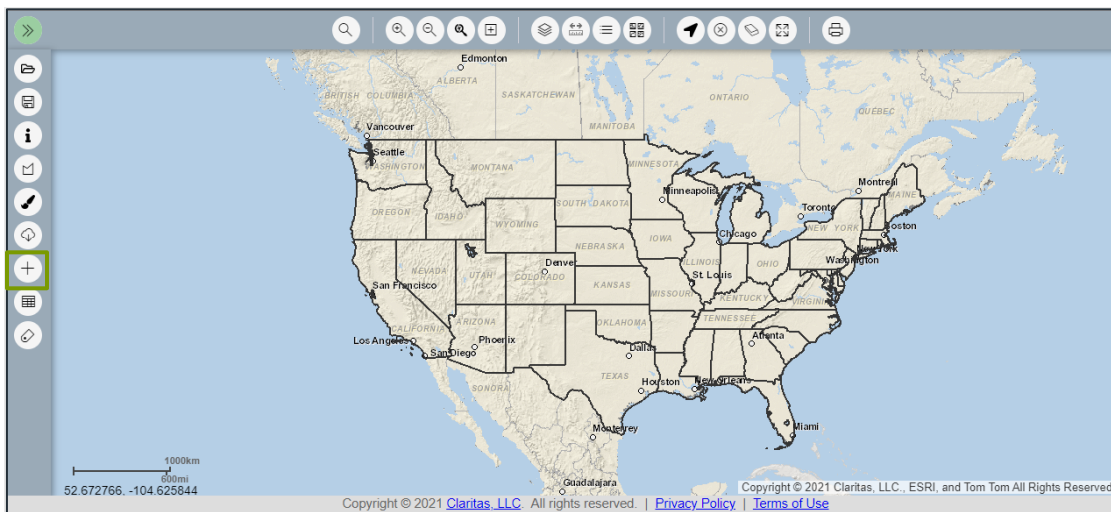
Add Map Layers

OVERVIEW

This document will take you through the process of adding layers to the interactive map.

ADD MAP LAYER

1. From the interactive map, click Add Layers.



2. Select the desired map layer type:

MAP LAYER TYPES	
LAYER TYPE	ADDITIONAL INFORMATION
Point	Displays points from a previously imported location file as a map layer. Note: Review the Location Builder Walkthrough for detailed steps on how to import location files.
Point Filter	Displays points from a previously created location filter as a map layer. Note: Review the Location Filter Walkthrough for detailed steps on how to create a filter using either imported locations or Claritas Business-Facts® data.
Geography	Displays previously saved analysis areas and/or geographies as a map layer.

3. Specify the layer details.

- For Point layers:
 - Select the desired location file/s.
 - If you would like to add the layer as an image, or if the layer contains 5,000 or more locations, click to select the *Add Layer as image?* option.

Note: If the layer is added as an image, you will not be able to reorder the layer within Layer Control.

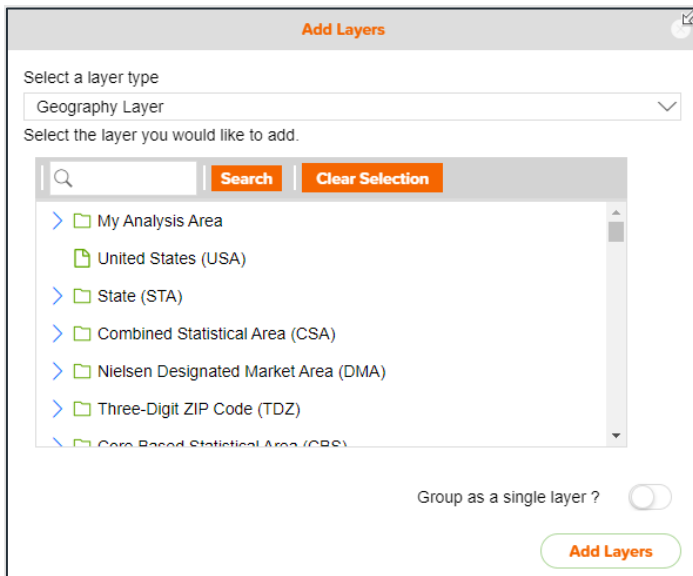

- For Point Filter layers:
 - Select the desired location filter.

- For Geography layers:
 - Select previously saved analysis areas and/or geographies.
 - Specify if you would like the selected areas to be grouped as a single layer.
 - If selected, all selected areas will be grouped as a single layer within Layer Control. This option will allow you to simultaneously edit the appearance of the grouped geographies.
 - If left unselected, each selected area will be displayed as a separate layer within Layer Control.



4. Click Add Layers to add the layer/s to the map.
