OVERVIEW

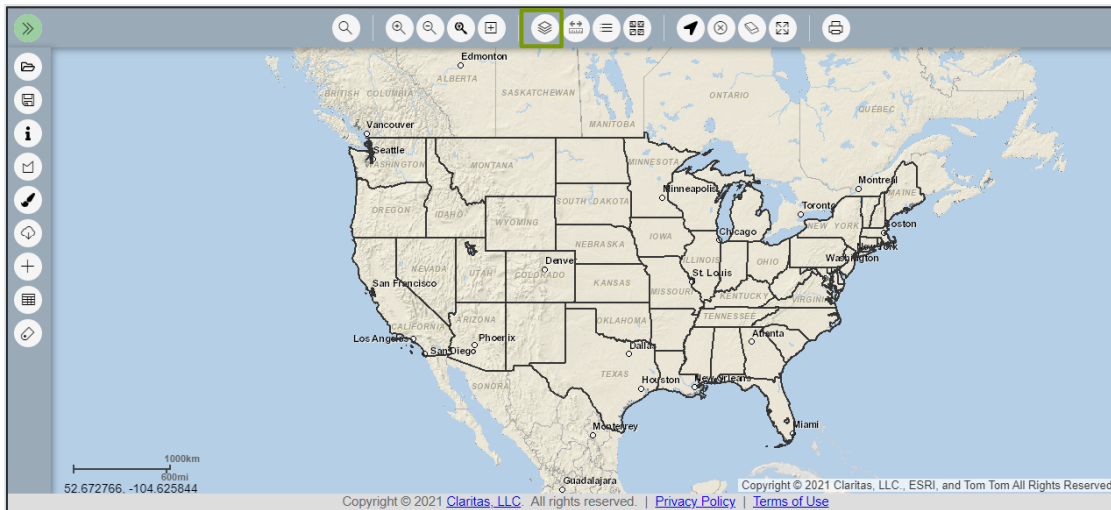
This document will take you through the process of using Layer Control within the interactive map.

The Layer Control feature allows you to:

- Display/hide layers on the map
- Include/remove layers from the map legend
- Set the layer's label, label style and symbol style
- Reorder the draw order of the layers on the map

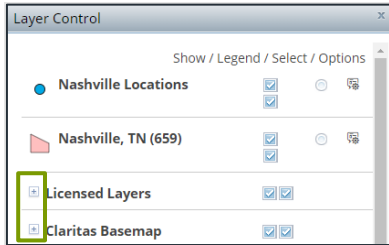
LAYER CONTROL

From the interactive map, click Layer Control.



Show/Legend/Select

(Optional) Click the + to the left of the list you want to expand.



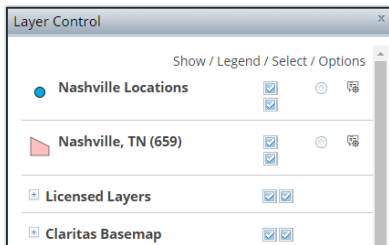
Click the corresponding box/button next to the desired layer to perform any of the following:

LAYER CONTROL OPTIONS	
OPTION	ADDITIONAL INFORMATION
Show	Show/hides the layer on the map.
Legend	Displays/removes the layer from the map legend.
Select	Makes the layer selectable on the map. Note: The system automatically enables the Show/Hide checkbox of the selectable layer, making it visible on the map.

Reorder Layers

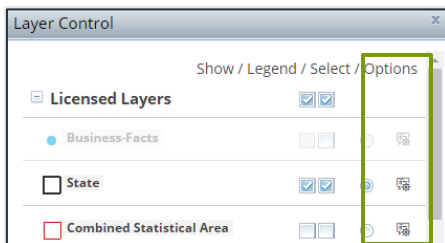
To change the draw order of the layers on the map, drag and drop a specific layer to the desired placement.

Note: Licensed Layers and the Claritas Basemap cannot be reordered.







Layer Options

Click the Layer Options next to the desired layer.



Within Layer Options, the below modifications can be made:

LAYER OPTIONS	
LAYER OPTION	ADDITIONAL INFORMATION
Show Label	 <p>From the Set Layer Label dropdown, specify the desired layer label and click Show Label.</p>
Label Editor	 <p>If Show Label is selected, click the Label Editor to make any of the below modifications to the displayed layer label:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Label font, size and color • Halo size and color • Label offset position <p>Click Apply Style to update the Label display on the interactive map.</p>
Zoom to Extent	 <p>Click Zoom to Layer Extent to zoom to the extent of a specific layer.</p>
Style Editor	 <p>Click Style Editor to make any of the below modifications to the layer:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Layer fill color and transparency • Layer outline color, transparency, line width and pattern • Symbol shape and size (for point layers only) <p>Click Apply to update the layer's style. Click Close Styler to close the Style Editor without making any changes to a layer's display.</p>
