

Point to Point Report

OVERVIEW

This document will take you through the process of creating a Point to Point report.

The Point to Point report is used to calculate distance and direction between an imported or filtered location data set to another imported or filtered location data set.

LOCATE THE REPORT

1. From the homepage, click on Reports.



2. Select Standard Reports → Location Reports → Point to Point.

SELECT REPORT INPUTS

Select Source Locations

1. Select the imported locations or Claritas Business-Facts® filter that will be used as the source data set. This data set is where the source locations will be pulled from.

2. Select the location(s) from the source data set that you want included in your report.

3. (Optional) Specify to include additional variables from your source data set.
 - a. Click the OFF button next to Include additional source variables to set it to ON.

Select Destination Data Set

1. Select the imported locations or Business-Facts® filter that will be used as the destination data set. This data set is where the destination locations will be pulled from.

2. (Optional) Specify to include additional variables from your destination data set.
 - a. Click the OFF button next to Include additional destination variables to set it to ON.

3. (Optional) Set the maximum distance that destination locations can be from the source locations.
 - a. Click the OFF button next to Use distance limit to set it to ON.


Use distance limit ON

- b. Enter a Distance Limit to set the maximum distance, in miles, that source and destination locations will be located from one another.


Enter a Distance Limit

4. (Optional) Limit the number of destination locations that will be included for each source location.

a. Click the OFF button next to Limit Destination(s) per Source to set it to ON.



b. From the dropdown, Select number of destinations per source.



Specify Report Output Details


1. Enter a report name. Click Submit.



REVIEW REPORT OUTPUT
