Using a Segment Summary file

OVERVIEW

Using Profile Builder, you can import a previously created profile. This file will include columns for segment code, summarized base counts and summarized profile counts for each segment.

LOCATE PROFILE BUILDER

1. From the homepage, click on Consumer Targeting.



2. Select Profile Builder.



3. Select where your profile data will be coming from. The options are:

UPLOAD A SEGMENT SUMMARY FILE

If you selected to upload a previously created profile, follow the below steps:

1. Select the segmentation system used in your segment summary file.

2. (Optional) If your file contains consumption data, change the Does the file contain consumption prompt to YES.



- 3. Click the Choose a file button. Navigate to and select the file that you want to upload.
 - The segment number column must have the word "Segment" somewhere in the title.
 - The base column(s) must have the word "Base" somewhere in the title.
